### **III.A. SYLLABUSES**

#### **13. New structure of the Lithuanian L1 oral examinations (2017-10-D-15-lt-1)**

The Board of Inspectors (Secondary) approved, with immediate entry into force, the 'New structure of the Lithuanian L1 oral examinations'. At its 19 June meeting, the BIS had already approved the part concerning the written examinations.

These two parts would be incorporated into the syllabus, which would be republished on the website, for **immediate** entry into force for the 2018 European Baccalaureate session.

### **III.C. EUROPEAN BACCALAUREATE**

#### **6. External audit of the European Baccalaureate written examination papers (oral)**

The BIS approved auditing of the subjects proposed, namely geography, chemistry, biology, 3-period and 5-period mathematics and physics.

The same subjects came back recurrently. It would be desirable to have a different procedure, not based on offer, so as to ensure that all subjects were audited regularly, and within a given period of time, to guarantee quality assurance. The Working Group charged with quality assurance of the European Baccalaureate was to study the matter.

#### **10. Proposal for harmonisation of L1 advanced written exams from 2021 (2017-01-D-53-en-1)**

The BIS approved the proposal to establish a harmonised advanced Language 1 examination model following the same principles as the harmonised examination model for Language 1. The Inspectors responsible for Language 1 must prepare an L1A examination model for the 2021 European Baccalaureate session at the latest – final approval would be given by the BIS at its June 2020 meeting at the latest.
