Decisions of the extraordinary meeting of the Joint Teaching Committee of 5 June 2020

III. ITEMS

1. COVID-19 – Follow-up on the Board of Governors and preparation of the 2020-2021 school year (2020-05-D-25-en-1) – A. BECKMANN

The Joint Teaching Committee examined document 2020-05-D-25-en-1. An exchange of views was held on the potential impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on the school year and the measures to be taken to mitigate the risks associated with the pandemic.

The Joint Teaching Committee decided to mandate the Office of the Secretary-General to set up a Task Force composed of representatives:

- of the nursery, primary and secondary Inspectors,
- of the Directors of the European Schools,
- of the Deputy Directors for the nursery, primary and secondary cycles of the ES,
- of the Directors of the Accredited European Schools,
- of the European Commission,
- of the ISTC (1 nursery/primary and 1 secondary),
- and of Interparents and
- staff members of the OSG.

During its work, the Task Force will also evaluate the suggestions made by certain members of the Joint Teaching Committee.

The Task Force will present to the Board of Governors for approval by means of the written procedure by the end of July at the latest, a risk assessment and concrete proposals to mitigate these risks for the 2020-2021 school year.
