2. **Reports on the follow-up on the Whole School Inspections of the European Schools:**
 - **Brussels III (2021-08-D-1-en-1)**
 - **Varese (2021-08-D-2-en-1)**
 - **Brussels IV (2021-08-D-3-en-1)**

The Joint Board of Inspectors approved the three reports on the follow-up on the Whole School Inspections of the Brussels III, Brussels IV and Varese Schools.

III.D. PEDAGOGICAL RULES AND STANDARDS

4. **Proposal to facilitate the integration of the eight key competences – New annexes to syllabuses and learning scenario template (2021-09-D-6-en-1)**

The JBI approved the learning scenario template (and the optional assessment grid) presented in document 2021-06-D-23 appended to this document.

The JBI also approved the cancellation of action 1.2 decided by the JBI (doc. 2019-09-D-50) and its replacement by these new proposals, presented in point 3 of this document.

6. **Induction of new Inspectors (2021-09-D-8-en-1)**

The JBI approved the document 'Induction of New Inspectors', with entry into force on 1 September 2022. The importance of appointing a mentor for new Inspectors was emphasised. The issue of Inspector training was also considered essential by the JBI. In that connection, this training could be organised just before the pedagogical meetings, for greater efficiency, as had already been the case in the past.

NB: As requested in the document, outside the meeting, and following the procedures, the Presidency approved the voluntary candidatures of two experienced Inspectors, Ms MUSILOVÁ (for Primary) and Ms HUISMAN (for Secondary), in order to work collaboratively with the OSG's units to set up the induction programme.

This document would cancel and replace document 2006-D-296 and would be published on the website when it came into force. It would also be appended to document 2021-09-D-35 'Inspectorate of the European Schools'.

This decision would be communicated to the Budgetary Committee and to the Board of Governors for their information.

III.F. OTHER ITEMS

2. Transfer application for the post of Deputy Director for the secondary cycle at the European School, Brussels II (2021-09-D-55-en-1)

The Joint Board of Inspectors approved the transfer application for the post of Deputy Director for the secondary cycle at the European School, Brussels II, with effect from 1 September 2022.

5. Areas of interest and expertise of the Inspectors of the Nursery-Primary and Secondary cycles of the European Schools (2021-09-D-3-fr-en-2)

The Joint Board of Inspectors approved the document, subject to additions concerning the recently appointed Inspectors.

6. Pedagogical Development and Quality Assurance of the European Schools (2020-2021) – Follow-up on 30 June 2021 (2020-08-D-1-fr-5)

The JBI approved the document, which, as was the customary procedure, would be appended to the joint report of the French Presidency 2020-2021.

**7. Pedagogical Development and Quality Assurance of the European Schools (2021-2022) – Short and long-term planning (2021-07-D-31-fr-1)
+ Report of the 'Quality Assurance' WG – (2021-09-D-73-en-1)**

Subject to the additions or changes to be communicated to the Pedagogical Development Unit, the JBI approved the document 'Pedagogical Development and Quality Assurance of the European Schools (2021-2022) – Short and long-term planning'.

The JBI also endorsed the proposal to set up a new interim ad hoc Working Group for the Brexit-related transition, to support the Inspectors in charge of the EN language.

8. Planning of the Inspectors' 2021 activities (2021-01-D-66-en/fr-2)

The JBI approved the document subject to the necessary additional information that the Inspectors were requested to provide.
