III. ITEMS/DECISIONS

- Training Policy on the Provision of Educational Support and Inclusive Education in the European Schools (document 2021-01-D-30-en-5)

The European Commission welcomes the document and the training policy. The EC insists on the fact that this Policy doesn't include extra costs for the 2021&2022 budgets, but underlined that it will have an impact as from the 2023 budget.

However, as it was explained that the Budgetary Committee had already made decisions in 2016 and 2018 in similar conditions (i.e. on proposals having budgetary implications for the following years that had not been approved yet), the EC endorsed the Training Policy.

EUIPO supports the EC position.

The Netherlands approves the proposal but encourages to fund it by means of internal redeployment of the budget.

Spain encouraged an inclusive education, supports measures and the training policy.

Poland and Ireland support the training policy.

The Budgetary Committee unanimously approved the Training Policy on the provision of Educational Support and Inclusive Education in the European Schools. The Budgetary Committee highlights that the financial impacts are neutral concerning the 2021 and 2022 budgets.
