### **III. POINTS**

#### **III.A. SYLLABUSES**

##### **1. Artistic Education – Secondary cycle – 2016-08-D-1-en-5 – A. Coenen**

The BIS approved, for immediate entry into force, the amendments made to the attainment descriptors for the end of S7 and the changes to the generic matrix and marking system for the Artistic Education syllabus for the secondary cycle.

##### **2. Amendment of the BAC written examination template for the S6-S7 History syllabus – 2013-01-D-35-en-9 – R. Juranova**

The BIS approved, for immediate entry into force, the new amendment made to the BAC written examination template in annex 3 for the S6-S7 History syllabus, replacing the previous decision made in October 2021.

##### **3. Amendment of the BAC written examination template for the Advanced Lithuanian Language 1 syllabus – 2020-05-D-19-lt-4 – J. Veniute-Vaicikauskiene**

The BIS approved, for immediate entry into force, the amendment of the BAC written examination template for the Advanced Lithuanian Language 1 syllabus. The BIS approved, for immediate entry into force, the inclusion in the syllabuses of assessment sheets for the oral examinations and annulled and replaced its previous decision concerning oral examination assessment sheets, which had been taken during the BIS meeting in June 2021: *'The BIS decided that, as regards the assessment criteria for oral examinations, in order for teachers to be informed as quickly as possible, they should be issued no later than the start of the school year so that they could be presented at the meetings in October. These sheets should be published in a separate document and not in the syllabus.'*
