3. **External audit of the written tests for the European Baccalaureate 2023 (University observation) – Oral – E. RUDOMINO**

The BIS approves the following list of subjects to be audited for the 2023 session of the European Baccalaureate:

Biology, Chemistry and 3 and 5 period Mathematics, Physics, English L2 and Art.

After the meeting of the BIS, following receipt of a significant number of remarks, Ms BUGIA asked that Economics be added to the list of subjects submitted for University Observation.

III.D. TEACHING RULES / STANDARDS

1. **Guidelines and processes relating to the document NMS materials – Assessment marking sheet for oral examinations – 2022-05-D-23-en-1 – M. BORDOY**

The BIS has taken note and approves the document Guidelines and processes linked to the NMS materials and to the Oral test assessment sheet.

In order to avoid errors and transcription differences liable to give rise to appeals, the BIS has also approved the following approach:

- Only the latest version compiling the final versions of the NMS materials – the oral test assessment sheet, checked by the Quality Assurance Working Group, will be presented in October 2022 for final approval.
- This compendium will be sent to the Schools in a timely manner in order to permit a degree of flexibility in finalising the process of updating the syllabuses. When the whole process is complete, i.e. when all of the updated final syllabuses (including the documents for the oral tests) have been published on the eursc.eu website – by January 2023 at the latest – the compendium will be definitively halted.
