III.B. REPORTS

1. Report of the Whole School Inspection at the European School of Mol on May 16th-20th, 2022 (2022-06-D-14-en-1)

The JBI approves the report on the whole school inspection at the Mol European School.

2. Report of the Whole School Inspection at the European School Brussels II from 7th to 11th March 2022 (2022-04-D-11-en-1)

The JBI approves the report on the whole school inspection at the Brussels II European School.

3. Report on the follow-up of the Whole School Inspection at the European School Luxembourg II from 2nd to 6th March 2020 (2022-09-D-69-en-1)

The JBI approves the monitoring report on the whole school inspection at the Luxembourg II European School.

4. Summary of the third round of the Whole School Inspections (PPT)

The JBI approves the summary of the third cycle of the whole school inspections.

2. Procedure to validate Assistive/Compensatory Technology for Assessment in the European Schools (2022-08-D-6-en-2)

The Joint Board of Inspectors approves the current procedure for proposing, analysing and validating assistive technologies (AT) with immediate effect. It sends its decision to the JTC.

7. Evaluation of Locally Recruited Teachers – Follow up report from the “Roles and Duties of Inspectors” Working Group (2022-09-D-70-en-1)

The Joint Board of Inspectors approves the mandate request of the two working groups (Roles and Duties of Inspectors and Evaluation of LRTs) to carry out this analysis jointly and include this request/mandate among the Board’s priorities.

III.F. OTHER ITEMS

2. Domain of interest and expertise of the Inspectors of the Nursery-Primary and Secondary cycles of the European Schools 2022-04-D-18-fr/en-2

Subject to potential amendments or additions, the JBI approves the document.

3. Inspectors who leave the European Schools System (2022-07-D-26-en-2)

This document was presented at the Board of Inspectors meetings on 10 and 11 October, following which the volunteers got to know each other:

- Ms GRGEC will take over Economics and replace Mrs IGLESIAS in the Quality Assurance WG;
- Ms VERMEIRE will replace Ms COLEIRO in the Quality Assurance WG;
- Ms JURANOVA will replace Mr GIURUMESCU in the Harmonised planning WG
- Ms ARKLE will take responsibility for the Russian Language 5 complementary course;
- Following the departure of Ms COLEIRO, Mr CASSAR will take over EN languages (L3 and L4);
- Concerning Intermath, since Ms LACZYNSKA is currently exclusively a secondary cycle Inspector, the Inspectors responsible decided to switch roles: Mr ROME would become Chair and Ms LACZYNSKA Vice-Chair;
- For the Roles and Duties of Inspectors WG, Mr COENEN put himself forward for the secondary cycle and Mr CILLIEN for the nursery/primary cycle.
- Ms TSILOGIANNI replaces Ms NIKA in the Child Protection WG. The secondary cycle post remains vacant.

Inspectors are invited to volunteer to fill the vacant posts, especially in the case of geography (Baccalaureate subject) and, given the need to revise the guidelines on school trips, two Inspectors will have to volunteer (one for the nursery/primary cycle and one for the secondary cycle).

Subject to these latter additions, the JBI approves the document. It should be noted that, as permitted under the procedure, certain of the proposals were approved by the Presidency following the meeting.

4. Pedagogical Development and Quality Assurance of the European Schools (2021–2022) – Follow-up on 30 June 2022 (2021-07-D-31-en-5)

Subject to any amendments or additions, the JBI approves the document, which will subsequently be annexed to the 2021-2022 joint report of the Croatian Presidency.

5. Pedagogical Development and Quality Assurance of the European Schools (2022–2023) – Short and long-term planning (2022-09-D-40-en-1)

The JBI approves the document, subject to any corrections or modifications subsequently communicated to the Pedagogical Development Unit by the Inspectors. The Quality Assurance WG will collaborate with the ICT Unit to resolve the technical aspects.

7. Planning of the Inspectors' 2022 activities (2022-01-D-52-en/fr-2)

The JBI approves the 2022 Inspectors' activity plan, subject to the addition of data indispensable to budgeting and planning until the end of 2022.
