The attention of the BIS was drawn to the fact that certain subjects had not yet revised their criteria for evaluating the oral examinations of the 2023 Baccalaureate. An accelerated EP would be sent at the beginning of November for immediate entry into force for the 2023 EB. The approved document would be sent to the BoG for information purposes.
