#### III.B. REPORTS

1. **Report on School Failures and Repeat Rates in the European Schools – 2022 – Document 2022-09-D-30-en-1**

The Joint Teaching Committee approved the report on school failures and repeat rates in the European Schools (2022). The report will be presented on the margins of the meeting of the Board of Governors in December 2022. It will then be published on the website [www.eurasc.eu](http://www.eurasc.eu).

#### III.D. PEDAGOGICAL RULES AND STANDARDS

9. **Evaluation of Locally Recruited Teachers – Proposal for Procedures – Roles and Responsibilities – Document 2022-09-D-44-en-1**

The Joint Teaching Committee approved the proposal relating to the Procedures for Evaluating the Locally Recruited Teachers – Roles and Responsibilities – with immediate entry into force. These procedures would be applied directly to the evaluations scheduled for the 2022-2023 school year.

They would be attached in the annex to the document entitled Quality Teaching in the European Schools - Booklet (document 2015-09-D-3).

The Joint Teaching Committee instructed the “Locally Recruited Teachers” working group to prepare a single reference document for the evaluation of teachers (seconded and locally recruited teachers) in the European Schools.

#### III.E. OTHER POINTS

1. **Writing Fest 2023 in Primary Cycle – Year Two – 2022-09-D-50-en-1**

The Joint Teaching Committee approved the concept and organisation of a Writing Fest for three additional years in the primary cycle. This would make it possible to rationalise the organisational structures and systems of the Writing Fest and to plan it in the long term by incorporating it into the annual schedule, which would contribute to its development.

**2. Proposal to organise a Writing Fest in the Secondary Cycle – Document 2022-09-D-49-en-1**

The Joint Teaching Committee approved the organisation, with immediate effect, of a Writing Fest in the secondary cycle during the 2022-2023 school year for the European Schools and Accredited European Schools. It would be organised in November and December 2022 for the pupils in s5 writing in one of the 24 official languages of their choice.
