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# Decisions of the extraordinary enlarged meeting of the Board of Governors of the European Schools

Meeting of 27 October 2022, Brussels (hybrid)

Approved by written procedure No 2022/51 on 22 November 2022

**Point 4. Proposals for the Future structure of the Brussels European Schools (2022-10-D-17-en-1)**

The Board of Governors decided that the future structure of the Fifth European School Brussels is to be a fully-fledged school, with levels from Nursery 1 to Secondary 7.

The Board of Governors decided to take the final decision on the linguistic composition of the Fifth European School Brussels and the gradual implementation at its next meeting in December 2022 at the latest.

The document outlining the proposal will be submitted to the Budgetary Committee at the next meeting on 8-9 November for opinion. Provisional estimates with regards to financial and human resources impact will be provided to the Budgetary Committee for their meeting in November.

The Board of Governors agreed that, focusing on Model A2 and Model A3, the Central Enrolment Authority will draft the Guidelines for Enrolment Policy for the 2023-2024 school year on the basis of the following assumptions:

- The proposed transfer of language sections to the Fifth European School Brussels.
- The proposed transfer of the Greek satellite classes from ES Brussels 1-Berkendael site to and creation of a whole Greek language section in the Fifth ES Brussels.
- The proposed gradual roll out of Latvian and Slovak language sections into the Secondary cycle, in ES Brussels 1-Uccle site as of the 2023/24 school year at the earliest.
- The proposal for a gradual approach for an optimal use of the ES Brussels 1-Berkendael site and ES Brussels 2 – Evere site as of 2023, aiming at ceasing parallel structures in the same school.
- The proposal to amend the concept of protection of siblings by limiting the principle to the protection of siblings in the same cycle at the same school.
