III.A. SYLLABUSES

2. **Sustainability and Active Citizenship – Complementary course – s6–s7 – 2023-01-D-28-en-1 – P. O. OTTOSSON, M. WOLFF**

The Joint Teaching Committee approved the Sustainability and active citizenship – Complementary course – s6-s7 syllabus, which would enter into force on 1 September 2023 for s6 and 1 September 2024 for s7. Publication on the www.eursc.eu website in July 2023.

3. **Croatian Language 1 – Nursery and Primary Cycles – 2022-11-D-30-hr-1 – K. GRGEC**

The Joint Teaching Committee approved the Croatian Language 1 syllabus – Nursery and primary cycles, which would enter into force on 1 September 2023. Publication on the www.eursc.eu website at the end of June 2023.

4. **Danish Language I – Secondary cycle - Basic Course (s1-s7) and Advanced course (s6-s7) – 2015-01-D-36-da-8 – L. DAMKJAER**

The Joint Teaching Committee approved the changes in Annexes F and G relating to the written Baccalaureate examination, with immediate entry into force in s6 and entry into force on 1 September 2023 for s7. Applicable to the European Baccalaureate from the session of June 2024. Publication on the www.eursc.eu website, February 2023.

5. **Croatian Language I – Secondary Cycle – 2022-11-D-31-hr-1 – N. LOVRIC**

Given the need to have a syllabus for Croatian Language 1, the Joint Teaching Committee exceptionally approved its entry into force immediately after the teaching meetings on 11 February, for s1 to s7. Applicable to the European Baccalaureate session as of the June session 2023. Publication on the www.eursc.eu website, February 2023.

6. **Handbook Science Symposium (ESSS) – 2019-01-D-52-en-3 – M. WOLFF**

The Joint Teaching Committee approved the Handbook for the Science Symposium of the European Schools (ESSS) with immediate effect. Publication on the www.eursc.eu website, February 2023.

7. History 2 and 4 Periods –s6-s7 – 2022-11-D-32-en-1 – R. JURANOVA

The Joint Teaching Committee approved the 2- and 4-period History syllabus – s6-s7, which would enter into force on 1 September 2023 for s6 and on 1 September 2024 for s7. Applicable to the European Baccalaureate as of the June session 2025. Publication on the www.eursc.eu website in July 2023.

8. Italian Language I – Primary cycle – 2022-11-D-28-it-1 – C. RUBINACCI

The Joint Teaching Committee approved the Italian Language 1 syllabus – Primary cycle – with entry into force on 1 September 2023. Publication on the www.eursc.eu website at the end of June 2023.

9. Syllabus for all L3 Languages – Secondary cycle – 2022-11-D-33-en-1 – K. STEPPAN

Subject to changes of form, the Joint Teaching Committee approved the syllabus for all Language 3s – Secondary cycle, which would enter into force on 1 September 2023 for S1-s4 and s6 and on 1 September 2024 for s5 and s7. Applicable to the European Baccalaureate as of the June session 2025. Publication on the www.eursc.eu website in July 2023.

10. Syllabus for Protestant Religious Education – s1-s3 – 2022-07-D-30-en-1 – RELIGIOUS AUTHORITIES – M. KALOGRIDOU

The Joint Teaching Committee approved the Protestant religious education syllabus – S1-S3 – with entry into force on 1 September 2023. Publication on the www.eursc.eu website in July 2023.

11. Syllabus for Protestant Religious Education – s4-s5 – 2022-07-D-31-en-1 – RELIGIOUS AUTHORITIES – M. KALOGRIDOU

The Joint Teaching Committee approved the Protestant religious education syllabus – s4-s5 – with entry into force on 1 September 2023 for s4 and on 1 September 2024 for s5. Publication on the www.eursc.eu website in July 2023.

12. Syllabus for Protestant Religious Education – s6-s7 – 2022-07-D-32-en-1 – RELIGIOUS AUTHORITIES – M. KALOGRIDOU

The Joint Teaching Committee approved the Protestant religious education syllabus – s6-s7, which would enter into force on 1 September 2023 for s6 and on 1 September 2024 for s7. Publication on the www.eursc.eu website in July 2023.

13. Romanian Language 1 – s1-s3 – 2022-12-D-26-ro-1 – R. CERCIU

The Joint Teaching Committee approved the Romanian Language 1 syllabus – s1-s3, which would enter into force on 1 September 2023. Publication on the www.eursc.eu website in July 2023.

14. Curriculum - Second Language – Primary Cycle – 2022-11-D-27-en-1 – F. SCHIMEK

The Joint Teaching Committee approved the Curriculum syllabus –Language 2 – Primary cycle – with entry into force on 1 September 2023. Publication on the www.eursc.eu website at the end of June 2023.

III.D. PEDAGOGICAL RULES AND STANDARDS

1. Harmonisation of the Pedagogical Planning in the European Schools + Annex 3 Proposal to amend Article 26 of the General Rules of the ES (2023-01-D-61) – 2023-01-D-59-fr-1 – G. DUCATEZ

The Joint Teaching Committee approved the final procedural document with entry into force from September 2023. It also approved the consideration of harmonised pedagogical planning in teacher evaluation, with entry into force from September 2024. The approved procedural document would bear reference 2023-01-D-59-en-2 and those documents affected by these decisions would also be updated as a consequence.

With the exception of the Deputy Directors in the nursery and primary cycles, who reserved their opinion until all of the changes had been presented, the Joint Teaching Committee approved the work process schedule of the Assessment Primary Working Group that will be amended according to the decision expressed below.

It also approved the updates to the document Assessment Tools in the Primary Cycle of the European Schools – Ref.: 2013-09-D-38-en-10, listed in Annex 1 to document 2023-01-D 31. The entry into force of these updates was postponed until September 2024. All of the changes for the first and second semester would be presented at the pedagogical meetings in October 2023 for final approval, including the updating of the attainment descriptors.

3. Guidelines on Early Identification of the children's abilities and needs in the Nursery cycle of the European Schools – 2023-01-D-30-en-1 – D. MUSILOVA

The Joint Teaching Committee approved the *Guidelines for early identification of the skills and needs of a child in the nursery cycle of the European Schools* which would be annexed to the *Early Education Curriculum*.
