III.B. REPORTS

1. Report of the Whole School Inspection at the European Schools Munich from 14th to 18th November 2022 (2022-11-D-24-en-1)

The JBI approves the report on the whole school inspection at the Munich European School.

III.D. PEDAGOGICAL RULES AND STANDARDS

1. Transfer application for the post of Deputy Director for the nursery and primary cycle at the European School, Brussels II (2023-01-D-11-en-1)

The Joint Board of Inspectors approves the transfer request for the post of Deputy Director for nursery and primary at the European School, Brussels II, from 1 September 2023.

8. Proposal to revise the document “Teaching Standards” (2012-09-D-11-en-4 & 2012-09-D-11-en-4-bis) (2023-01-D-57-en-1)

The JBI approves the proposals made in the document by the Steering Committee for Whole School Inspections and gives a mandate to the “Teachers’ Evaluation” Working Group, which will therefore be reactivated, to update the Teaching Standards document (2012-09-D-11-en-4 & 2012-09-D-11-en-4-bis). The related documents will also be updated as a result.

III.F. OTHER ITEMS

2. Planning of the Inspectors' 2023 activities (2023-01-D-33-en/fr-1)

The JBI approves the document, assuming application of any additions or amendments subsequently communicated to the Pedagogical Development Unit.

3. Initial Planning for Team Activities of Inspectors for the School Year 2023-2024 (2023-01-D-27-en-1)

The JBI approves the Initial Planning for Team Activities of Inspectors for the School Year 2023-2024 with immediate entry into force.

The JBI also approves the proposal to designate a Primary Cycle Inspector to conduct evaluations of LRTs in the secondary cycle, and vice versa, in cases of need or last-minute cancellations, depending on the Inspectors available at the time.

4. Domain of interest and expertise of the Inspectors of the Nursery-Primary and Secondary cycles of the European Schools (2022-04-D-18-fr-en-4)

Subject to possible adaptations communicated to the UDP at a later stage, the JBI approves the document.

5. Inspectors who leave the European Schools' System (2022-07-D-26-en-5) :

- Appointment of the responsible persons for the subjects
- Replacement in the Working Groups
- New Working Groups

The JBI approves the proposed changes and asks the Inspectors to volunteer to fill the vacant posts in the Working Groups.

The JBI takes note of the fact that Mr OTTOSSON, Swedish Nursery/Primary Cycle Inspector, is leaving the European Schools system at the end of the school year.

The JBI approves the following changes:

- **Mr CILLIEN takes responsibility for physical education, replacing Mr SPITERI, and volunteers to coordinate the organisation of Eurosport unless another volunteer steps forward.**

After the departure of Mr OTTOSSON:

- **Mr GUERREIRO will succeed him as Chair of the “Discovery of the World” Working Group.**
- **Mr Rome will be responsible for the subject ICT for the primary cycle.**
- **Ms HUISMAN will become Chair of the Quality Assurance Working Group and Ms GRGEC will be Vice-Chair.**
- **A volunteer must step forwards to take charge of the Child Protection Working Group.**

Subject to these latter additions, the JBI approves the document. It should be noted that, as permitted under the procedure, some of the proposals were approved by the Presidency following the meeting.

7. Pedagogical Development and Quality Assurance of the European Schools (2022-2023) – Short and long-term planning (2022-09-D-40-en-3)

Assuming application of any additions or amendments subsequently communicated to the PDU, the JBI approves the document with immediate entry into force.
